The following is a list of requirements and expectations for attending the RJ Fisher Middle School "Winterfest" on January 24th. Attendance at the event requires that this form be signed by **BOTH** the student and the student's legal guardian.

REQUIREMENTS AND EXPECTATIONS - BEFORE EVENT

- A. This event is open to current **RJF students ONLY**. No guests, former students or siblings are allowed to attend.
- B. Students must present this signed permission slip at time of ticket purchase.**
- C. All tickets will be sold in the quad, during lunch from January 21-24.
- D. As per district policy students must be in good standing relative to school attendance and citizenship.

REQUIREMENTS AND EXPECTATIONS - DURING EVENT

- A. Students must show their **WRISTBAND** before entering any part of the event.
- B. All students must observe the District Dress Code Policy.
- C. All students must be in the event by 3:15.
- D. Students will not be permitted to leave early (**No Re-Entry**)
- E. All students will be released at 5:00 and are expected to leave campus immediately in the manner directed by their guardians.**
- F. This is a school-sponsored event and as such all students are expected to follow the same rules as they do during the school day. **NO CELL PHONES ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE EVENT.** Cell phones and all personal belongings should be placed in the student's backpack. All backpacks will be stored in the Library under adult supervision for the duration of the event.
